Moving / Setup:





• If you move your tool-setter to a new location on your table, you must:

Ensure the LED panel on back is angled toward your OMI receiver

Indicate stylus and re-calibrate

 *be sure to keep the same orientation when moving the system





Changing Stylus:









- If you need to replace a stylus, loosen the screw holding the stylus in place and replace.
- If your styli was broken you may also need to replace the break stem
- When you replace a stylus you MUST indicate so it is parallel in X and Y to the table (next page) then recalibrate

Indicating Stylus:



- When indicating, always adjust when the indicator is on one side.
- Adjust as close to zero as possible
- After adjusting left and right, now do front and back tilt. (next page)



Indicating Stylus:




- Repeat steps until an acceptable number is met
 - Under .0005 in preferably
- Be sure all adjustment screws are tight
 - Don't overtighten
- After you indicate X and Y you MUST Recalibrate your tool setting system



Calibration:





- What you need:
 - Tool with known length and diameter
 - Known Length in Offset, from Specified T# in O8026
 - Reference Diameter in R#
- Drive your calibration tool about half an inch, centered, above the Stylus
- Run O8026

O8026(OTS CALIBRATION)
(POSITION TOOL ABOVE AND CENTER OF OTS DISK)
(T1= H OFFSET- MUST CONTAIN LENGTH OF TOOL)
(R= REFERANCE DIA OF CAL TOOL)
(D= DIA OF OTS DISK)

Basic Maintenance:






- The most basic maintenance you can do is:
 - Keep the LED lens clean
 - Recalibrate
 - Replace Batteries

Batteries:





- To replace batteries simply un-screw the back cover and put new batteries in
- Do not deflect the stylus while it goes through the new battery LED cycle
- No Recalibration needed

Basic Troubleshooting:



- If your tool setter will not turn on, or flashes blue/green LEDs when on
 - Replace batteries
- If your tool setter blinks Ren LEDs with nothing deflecting stylus contact PQI
